## 2025 Rules of Play

- 1. The Monday Night Golf League will play United States Golf Association (USGA) Rules, except for the local rules listed below.
  - A. A ball lying in fairway or rough may be "rolled", not more than one club length, to provide a preferred lie, not nearer the hole.
  - B. Lost ball in the event of a lost ball, player shall drop a ball near the last place seen with one shot penalty. Drop area must be agreed to by player and opponent.
  - C. Out of Bounds place a ball at the edge of the hole's fairway across from where the ball went out of bounds and no closer to the hole with a penalty of two shots or re-hit from original spot with two shot penalty.
- 2. Tees: All flights play White Tees. 65 years or older play Gold Senior Tees.
- 3. Dues for each member of the League will be **Forty Dollars** (\$40.00). All dues are non-refundable.
- 4. Call your opponent prior to league night to find out what time they will be there to minimize groups around the clubhouse. All league matches must be played by scheduled league night. If you are unable to play on league night, you may play your match prior to Monday if your opponent agrees and you must play head-to-head. Matching of scorecards is prohibited. You must sign, date and turn in your scorecard for matches played early at the pro shop. There is no limitation to how early you play your match as long as it is played no later than the scheduled Monday night. It is also suggested to text a picture of the card to John Kantz at 740-935-5525 if possible.
- 5. Scoring:
  - Maximum score on any hole is double par.
  - If neither opponent is in attendance, no points will be awarded. Each full-time member completing his round will receive two (2) show-up points. Substitutes get one (1) point for showing.
  - Absent golfers receive no show up points and forfeit total (medal) point but may earn points from the ghost round in that flight. (see GHOST SCORING below). If neither opponent shows, no points will be awarded.
  - Each three holes are worth 1 point and are match play. If there is a tie, the point is split. A fourth point is awarded by low gross score for the nine-hole match. If there is a tie, point is split.
  - If your opponent (or sub) does not show by 5:30 p.m., you must play with a league member (or approved player) to validate your round. Your scores will be match against your flight's ghost round (the median round in your flight that night) to earn the remaining 3 points. League secretary will calculate awarded points.
  - If the round is not completed, no points are awarded.

**Substitutes:** If a player(s) is unable to play his regularly scheduled league match (non-playoff match), a substitute may be made from the sub list. Each player will be responsible for obtaining an appropriate substitute from the sub list (player's flight or lower may be used). For example, a C Flight player may choose a C flight sub or a D Flight sub). Only players from the sub list, or players who have been determined eligible by a member of the Rules Committee, are eligible to substitute equal to or higher than their designated flight. If a player(s) is unable to play his regularly scheduled league match (non-playoff match), and no substitute shows, a ghost round will be posted.

**Ghost rounds** will be posted for any player unable to play his regularly scheduled league match (not applicable in playoffs), and no substitute shows. The league secretary or officer will calculate all matches involving a ghost round. A ghost round will be posted from the median flight score that day. If two scores represent the median, one will be randomly drawn from the two to represent that flight's ghost round. The absent player will not receive two (2) attendance points and forfeit the total (medal) point to the player present. The remaining three (3) points will be awarded by the INDIVIDUAL SCORING procedure matching the present player's card with the median score round that day. If both players are absent, and no subs show, no points will be awarded.

**POSTING SCORES:** A score sheet shall be provided in club house each week for recording scores and points. A signed scorecard by each player must be turned into the league secretary or deposited at the score sheet provided. At least one player should record the score(s) and points on the score sheet provided. However, it is each player's responsibility to see that his score is recorded properly. Once a score has been posted, <u>it will not be changed</u>. **MAKE SURE YOUR SCORECARD IS CORRECT. Text a picture to 740.935.5525** 

- 6. In the event a league member is absent three (3) matches during league season, the League Officers may declare such player ineligible for further play. The League Officers may assign another player in his place on the team or allow a ghost round to complete the year.
- 7. Matches will be scheduled for tee-off from 4:00 p.m. through 5:30 p.m. **IF YOU ARE GOING TO BE LATER THAN 5:15pm, PLEASE CALL CLUB HOUSE AND/OR YOUR OPPONENT.** No forfeits will occur prior to 5:30 p.m. on league night; the starter house clock will rule. Since all matches must be played with at least one other league member, any player whose opponent has not shown should go off with the last group. If the opponent shows prior to 5:30 p.m., the player will return to the first tee to begin the match, or play may begin on the course and prior holes being replayed.
- 8. If the match is played earlier than 4:00pm on Monday, YOU MUST RESERVE TEE TIMES.
- 9. In case of inclement weather, the decision to suspend play will be the responsibility of the club staff. The club staff' decision will stand. If all matches cannot be completed due to course closing, all matches will be cancelled, and no makeup night will be scheduled. League officers may cancel league after conferring with club staff prior to 4pm Monday if conditions appear warranted.
- 10. Each member's league averages and points will be computed and posted weekly on the bulletin board in the pro shop and on our web page: <u>http://mondayelks.tripod.com</u>
- 11. Season will consist of two 9-week halves with winners in each half. There will be no overall league winner.
